### WOMEN IN THE ARTS: A DIALOGUE ABOUT NATURE AND ENVIRONMENT

Stoart Korai Gallery of the Ethniki Insurance Company

The vision of this exhibition began to take shape in the winter of 2017. South-Korean-born artist Yumi Hogan – currently First Lady of the state of Maryland – and Greek artist Mina Papatheodorou Valyraki were introduced by Climis Lascaris and brought together by their shared interest in nature and the environment expressed through their art.

As Hogan and Valyraki started to collaborate, the exhibition began to take form organically with each bringing her multiple gifts, talents, and thoughts.

Both Hogan and Valyraki are included in the Permanent Collection of the National Museum of Women in the Arts in Washington, DC, which brings recognition to the achievements of women artists of all periods and nationalities by exhibiting, preserving, acquiring, and researching art by women and by teaching the public about their accomplishments.

Hogan draws on her memories and the traditions of her homeland to create abstract landscapes that reflect her response to the natural world. Using sumi ink and mixed media on traditional hanji paper, she creates depictions of her current environment and life experiences. Hogan's work has been featured in shows and museums in the United States and in South Korea. She received a BFA from the Maryland Institute College of Art (MICA) and an MFA from American University. A committed advocate of the arts and art education, she is an adjunct professor at MICA.

Valyraki studied at the Athens School for Fine Arts and earned a PhD. from the University of Florence. She has presented her work in numerous exhibitions around the world including the National Gallery in Athens, the Olympic Museum of Lausanne, the Jintai Art Museum of China, the ASAMA Museum of the United States Sports Academy in Alabama, and the United Nations Headquarters in New York. Valyraki has been an important artist in the sports world since the 1990s. Her one-woman shows include exhibitions at the Galleria Ca' d' Oro in Rome, 1993; at the 58th Monaco Grand Prix in Monte Carlo, 2000; at the Olympic Winter Games in Torino, 2006; at Frascione Arte Gallery in Florence, 2010; at the 34th "Milano International FICTS Fest" at Palazzo Giureconsulti in Milano, 2016; and many others.

In 2002, the United States Sports Academy named Valyraki 'Sport Artist of the Year.' Her work, "The Downhill Skier" became one of the official posters for that year's Salt Lake City Winter Olympics. In 2004 and in 2008

she was granted the "Guirlande D' Honneur" at the "SPORT MOVIES & TV–Milano International FICTS" Festival.

She has also been granted with the "IOC TROPHY 2014 – ART AND SPORT" award by the International Olympic Committee and the United States Sport Academy "Sport Artist of the year 2002-2004" award.

Regarding her work the famous art critic Guiliano Serafini has written:

"Mina's style – I am referring to the nervous and broken brushwork, to the extreme freedom of sign that trespasses in dripping up to the violent explosions of pure pigment - becomes, in short, just like in an ideographical alphabet, which is the "form" and "content" of Mina Papatheodorou-Valyraki's work.

It is as if the artist is challenging the evidence of vision, in what her fluid, wide brushwork allows running and "sedimenting" on the canvas surface. It is a pictorial gesture that is always seeking large dimensions, even when space is physically limited. Everything in Mina's work is being "thought" on this large scale. This is what we see in the emaciated silhouettes of the cranes traced and sketched on a background of yellow and silver and also in the race cars whose darting design look as if it is dilating itself in a sort of visual deflagration, where the whole tension is revealed as well as the outburst and the virtual movement. It is a dynamism which involves also the colour that the artist handles in a audacious and often dissonant way, colour always becomes the "accomplice" of sign and its excitement".

The "Trees" are one of the last subject series of expression for Mina. Nature as a concept that surrounds everybody and everything, is expressed here in its simplest form from the design point of view. Still the extremely strong lines pass on the message: there are no limits in being. The background colors, on which the composition is being developed, all become a fascination guide in the journey that has been chosen by the spectator; the one that is dreamt to travel in the perpetual space of his own existence.

We are thrilled to share with you the art of these two talented women. Lee Anne and William Geiger, of the Geiger Family Foundation and Patrons of the National Museum of Women in the Arts, stated, "It's important to honor the women who fought their way through and insisted on being shown, and are now recognized."



#### **Artist Statement**

My artwork is my interpretation and abstract vision of the harmony of nature. We human beings are part of nature like cool breezes, trees and flowing water. I feel this existence in the meaning of nature through the freedom of movement and unstructured imagery. All of our lives are connected in this way.

Some of my works depict the sudden change that has affected my life. I began to use more colors and lines. The flowing colors and lines represent a childhood memory of my mother and grandmother making silk fabrics, carefully moving each silk strand in the air. I am reminded of the soft colorful strands, swaying with the breeze.

This work is my interpretation and abstract vision of the harmony of nature. We human beings are part of nature like cool breezes, trees and flowing water. All of our lives are connected in this way. Rather than replicate a scene, each of my paintings has no beginning, no end, and no focal point but represents a continuous flow as if wondering through a dream. It is my intent to make people feel and understand the breath of nature through my works.



















#### MINA PAPATHEODOROU VALYRAKI Artist Statement

I consider my art purely gestural painting, which reveals my feelings at that moment, including some periods of "moderation" which render it slightly calmer. If we were to isolate little pieces from one of my works we would see that they are autonomous too, because they represent what I am: energetic and hyperactive, restless.

I believe that there are two components which may be said to characterize my work: a decisively secure draft, that ensures the structure of the composition and the intensity of the colour, which gesturally follows the flow of the composition with a creative dialogue between materials and canvas. Most often this process is incorporated. The drawing arises from the colour; by that I mean that the intensity itself is due to this inner mood and to the energy and mobility that characterize me. Besides, painting and every other form of art, is a psychographic result.

Personally, I find the limitation –of the small frame- unbearable. In large artworks I am not restricted of boundaries. I always want to go beyond the frame, anyway. Almost all my artworks are cut off. The rest of their 'being', the imaginary, exists outside, over and beyond the frame. It is impossible in the case of gestural painting for only small and worthy works to come out, unless one is dealing with a polyptych, where one piece completes or is the continuation of the next.

An artist does not become better or more able with the passing of time. However, by searching and by the way in which somebody penetrates into his-her own exploration, can alternate the expressions and quests. Of course, the life phases, the mood and the way in which the artist confronts things around, play an important role. My gestural painting has always been existing in my life, since I was born. The period of the greys and dark blues are some of the most basic, important and beloved ones for me. Some might think that the dark range reflects an unhappy period, but concerning me, it is quite the opposite. What has changed is my inclination towards large surfaces and more light, or perhaps alternated light and the mood towards freedom.
















